- ◆ Manage entry into the beer garden (check IDs)
- ◆ Assisting in other concession stands

For the 3rd and the 5th, we are looking for approximately 40 volunteers, but the more the better. For the day of the event, on the 4th, we are looking for approximately 50-100 volunteers to cover 1 or 2 shifts. This event draws HUGE crowds, so there will be plenty of work to go around.
